Entrepreneurship at Expertise France

Expertise France contributes to the development and structuring of entrepreneurial ecosystems. It thereby stimulates the creation of companies generating wealth and employment. Its activities are in line with the Sustainable Development Goals and national strategies for private sector development.

The French international technical cooperation agency offers technical and strategic support, as well as measures for financial support and training. The network of public partners, entrepreneurship support structures and expertise mobilised enable the implementation of programmes working on both the macroeconomic and microeconomic dimensions, thereby activating international cooperation or "South-South" cooperation.



A co-construction approach

In response to the needs identified, Expertise France takes a co-construction approach with the various stakeholders to design programmes that aim to contribute to establishing an enabling institutional environment, a public-private dialogue, and sustainable and inclusive economic development. More broadly, the ownership and institutionalisation of interactions between the State, the private sector and civil society foster the emergence of entrepreneurship and its development.

Expertise France helps build the skills of organisations through technical assistance, the allocation of grants and the mobilisation of expertise. It also contributes to refining and implementing regulatory reforms to improve the business climate, investment and business creation.

Expertise France uses its experience to support the creation of financing mechanisms, training in entrepreneurship and innovation mechanisms which help build sustainable and structuring activities. The range of services it has developed is gradually being expanded to cover the value chain of the journey of entrepreneurs operating in various sectors of activity and at different stages of development.

AFRICA

AEDIB NET – STRENGTHENING DIGITAL INNOVATION ECOSYSTEMS BETWEEN EUROPE AND AFRICA

2021-2024 | €0.37 M | European Union

AEDIB NET aims to strengthen a common African-European digital innovation ecosystem by supporting digital innovation and start-up ecosystems in Africa and facilitating partnerships between European and African digital innovation hubs.

With this project, Expertise France is helping inspire players in the ecosystem by developing an enabling policy framework for innovation, building the capacities of marginalised groups, and improving digital and entrepreneurial skills.

TUNISIA

EFOR – IMPROVING GENDER EQUALITY IN THE AGRICULTURE SECTOR

2023-2026 | €4.5 M | Agence Française de Développement

This project aims to contribute to women's empowerment and improving conditions for them in the agriculture sector.

One project component is devoted to work on social norms related to gender, while another focuses on climate change adaptation and the processing and marketing of agricultural products. This project is implemented in three governorates in Tunisia: Gafsa, Béja and Kasserine.

FAST – HELPING STRUCTURE WOMEN'S ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN TUNISIA

2021-2024 | €0.9 M | Agence Française de Développement

Implemented by the Tunisian Caisse des Dépôts et des Consignations, with technical assistance from Expertise France, FAST aims to assist entrepreneurship support structures involved in various issues:

- Specific support to women in regional areas
- Scaling-up for start-ups
- · Links with large companies

LIBYA

RAQAM-E

2020-2022 | €1.1 M | Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs

This project aims to create the first network of coding schools in Libya in the municipalities of Benghazi, Janzour, Misurata, Sebha and Tripoli. These schools aim to train 200 young people a year and 22 trainers in 12 coding schools in 3 months.

At the same time, Expertise France is contributing to the creation of a co-working space for "mumpreneurs", young women entrepreneurs with children between the age of 0 and 3 years, in Janzour.

BLUE ECONOMY, FISHERIES AND AQUACULTURE PROJECT

2021-2025 | €20.7 M | European Union

The project aims to contribute to the development of the blue economy in Algeria by supporting the entrepreneurial ecosystem, research centres and universities.

The activities implemented benefit coastal communities and contribute to a more rational use of resources and to environmental protection.

MEET AFRICA 2: European mobilisation for entrepreneurship in Africa

2020-2023 | €8.5 M | European Union and Agence Française de Développement

MEET AFRICA 2 contributes to structuring Euro-African entrepreneurship ecosystems and provides support to diaspora entrepreneurs.

Through this project, Expertise France is helping to create economic activities and jobs in Africa, by increasing the mobilisation of talent and financial resources from African diaspora living in Europe and/or newly resettled in Africa.

PALESTINE

SUPPORT TO THE MUSIC INDUSTRY

Expertise France is helping to structure and develop Palestine's music ecosystem, especially musical creation, among Palestinian young people.

The objective is to allow artists to earn a decent income from their creations by adapting the legal framework and guaranteeing their copyright. The project also contributes to the development of vocational training and musical entrepreneurship, in particular through innovation and digital technology.

SUPPORT TO THE MUSIC INDUSTRY

The project to support the music industry in Ghana is based on two lines of action:

- The remuneration and protection of artists
- The creation of venues, as well as social and environmental responsibility issues.

It is conducted in partnership with the Creative Arts Agency, the agency of the Ghanaian Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture, set up in 2020 to promote creative industries, including music.
