In support for the deployment of AFD's SUNREF green credit line, the technical assistance aims at assisting and building the capacities of project initiators and commercial banks, in order to identify and finance EE/RE projects.

Expertise France:

- Oversees the global coordination of the project
- Creates a portfolio of EE/RE bankable projects eligible for financing from the credit line (+ than 200)
- Coaches project initiators: technical and financial studies, etc.
- Strengthens the capacities of partner banks financing EE/RE projects

ENERGOS II – Supporting decentralised rural electrification with renewable energy and increasing energy efficiency in public buildings - Ivory Coast

ENERGOS II aims to enhance access of rural communities to energy services, contribute to increasing electricity generation capacity by using renewable energy, and reduce energy consumption in public buildings.

Expertise France:

- Provides isolated rural areas with off-grid electricity systems using renewable energy
- Reduces energy consumption in public buildings in Abidjan
